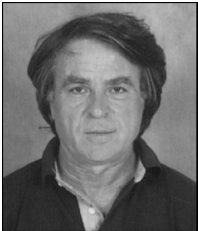
## 1. Competition Management

#### ii. Resume Sport Coordinator

Dimitris Christodoulou and his team are responsible for organising the Sailing Events for the NatWest Island Games Rhodes 2007 XII. He passed the test of an ISAF Race management seminar and also participated in the Athens 2004 Olympic Games. For many years he has been involved with organising sailing events and the development of sailing in Rhodes.

## 2. Rules

- a. The Competition of all sports at the Rhodes 2007 NatWest Island Games will follow the International rules set by the respective International Federation. The NatWest Island Games Sailing competitions will be governed by the rules as defined in the RACING RULES of SAILING 2005-2008. No national authority prescriptions will be apply. - b. By laws. According to the IGA Constitution separate rules for the Island Games are written and revised by the Technical Committee after the end of the last Island Games Competition. The IGA Executive Committee is responsible to approve any changes. The finals bylaws approved for the Rhodes 2007 NatWest Island Games and were published in October 2006 by IGA are:

### Sailing By-laws

#### 1 Competition Rules

- 1.1 All sailing events will be held under the International Sailing Federation (ISAF) rules.

#### 2 Sailing Events

- 2.1 The primary sailing event shall be a competition held in International Laser class dinghies. The Host Island may also include additional competition(s) in a keelboat of its choice.
- 2.2 If Sail Boarding (Windsurfing) events are included then all boards must be of the same design and shall be provided by the organisers. The rules of competition shall comply with those laid down by the International Sailing Federation with appropriate amendments made by the controlling authority. There will not be any weight categories. There will be an individual event within the team event.

**3 Island Representation**

- 3.1 A maximum of two entries per island for Laser Standard rig.  
A maximum of two entries per island for Laser Radial rig.  
Note: Competitors may only compete in one laser class.
- 3.2 In Wind surfing, a maximum of four competitors may represent an Island.
- 3.3 In other competitions numbers will be dependent on the events being staged.

**4 Competition Officials**

- 4.1 Numbers and qualifications required would be dependent on the events being staged.

## 3. Competition Facilities

**a. Description:**

- The sailing competition will take place in the Nautical Club of Rhodes facilities, next to the swimming pool, located in the northern end of the island in the centre of Rhodes Town. These facilities are used by the Sailing department of the Nautical Club of Rhodes
- b. All competition venues will open on the 29 June 2007 and will close according to the end of Competition of each sport

## 4. Competition Clothing

We encourage the member Islands participating in Sailing to wear light clothing.

## 5. Extra Services

- a. Water will be provided by the Organizing Committee for all athletes.
- b. In order to provide our participating islands the best possible service, there will be a weather forecast distributed on the beginning off every day's session at the venue and at the Sports Information Centre.

## 6. Transportation

Transportation during the Rhodes 2007 NatWest Island Games is organized and provided, to accredited persons, by the Organising Committee. Transportation services begin for the arrival of the teams until their departure. Officially, the transportation to the Venues and the Games Village will start on the 29 July until the 6 July 2007. A transport plan has been organized and includes Transport from and to the Airport, four Shuttle Bus lines, direct transport to venues as well as direct transport to venues not included in the shuttle lines. The organising committee will try to fulfill all transport needs to and from the venues according to the needs of each Sport. See the shuttle bus map on page 22.

## 7. Sport Party

It is tradition in the Island Games history that each sport does its own separate party. The Sport Party for sailing is scheduled for Thursday 5 July at 21:00 at the Nautical Club Facilities.

## 8. Test Event

For the best preparation of the Rhodes 2007 NatWest Island Games the Organising Committee will cooperate with the local sport organisations to organise events to test the planning of the Games.
